The Pet Food Shelf (formerly known as People and Pets Together) is a pet food shelf offering dog food, cat food, pet supplies, toys, and more. The Bond Between pet food shelf is open to residents of the city of Minneapolis. We provide dog and cat food, and pet care items, to individuals and families in crisis. Clients who live outside of the city of Minneapolis (as defined by zip code) are allowed to shop once every six months. Clients who live within Minneapolis can shop once every 30 days. Service is limited to one household member (as defined by unique address) and is capped at four dogs and/or cats total.
